8 Sections Designed for all Levels, Unrated players welcome!

Championship: Includes the top rated players from all grade levels.
Under 1500: For players in all grades with ratings below 1500.
HS Premier: For players in grades 9-12 with ratings below 1000.
MS Premier: For players in grades 6-8 with ratings below 1000.
Elem Premier: For players in grades K-5 with ratings below 1000.
MS Reserve: For players in grades 6-8 with ratings below 500.
4-5 Reserve: For players in grades 4-5 with ratings below 500.
K-3 Reserve: For players in grades K-3 with ratings below 500.
Unrated players may play in any grade appropriate section.

\$1,000 College Scholarship awarded to the overall individual winner of the Championship Section, determined by adding the scores from each player's best three events.

Awards: Trophies to top 5 players in each section at each event, and all players scoring 3 or more points. Participation awards to all players in K-8 at each event. Everyone is a winner! Team trophies will be presented to the top 2 school teams in each section at the last event, based on the accumulated scores from the best three tournaments. Team scores at each event are determined in each section by adding the best 4 individual scores per school.
