**Elite Section only open to players over 1900 USCF or FIDE.*

*Unrated Players may win no more than 50% of any prize **except** in the Elite and U2200 Sections.*

Unofficial ratings may be used for unrated players.

2-Day Schedule: Registration ends at 9 am Saturday.

Rounds: Saturday 10-1:30-5, Sunday 9:00-3:00.

Entry Fee: \$120 by 3 pm 8-8, \$130 at site or online until one hour before round one.

IM's, GM's free, \$100 deducted from prize winnings.

Reentry: \$50, not available for Elite or U2200 Section.

Free USCF membership for scholastic players, new or expired memberships only.

Byes: Half point byes okay, limit 2, not round 5, must request before round 2 pairings are posted.

Doubles Bonus Prize: \$200-100. Best male/female or female/female 2-player "team" combined score among all sections. Must average under 2200; may play in different sections. Register by 5 PM Saturday, August 9th. Prize limits do not apply to Doubles Bonus Prize. No additional fee to register.
